DCEO FRAUD AND ABUSE REPORTING

Our State Agency reached out recently to make us aware of scams ongoing throughout the State where persons are trying to represent agency staff members or State staff and asking for clients to send in Personal Identifiable Information (PII).

Know that our agency NEVER uses Facebook Messenger; we also will never text you asking for any personal information. You may get a reminder message or email if you schedule an appointment with us and it will tell you what to bring, but never asking for that information to be sent through unsecure means.

This is one of the reasons that when a client schedules a phone appointment with us, we require you, the client, to call us on your appointment date and time, so that you know you are talking to the correct people when giving out your information.

Please do **NOT** ever give information out if you do not know with whom you are speaking. Protect your information and identity. We will also never attempt to collect funds or require payment for services rendered at our agency.
